

Date Tag – Version 2.0

Description:

Here is a simple ShowMe Indicator that allows you to tag a particular date. I use to mark a date that may have meaning for my trading. You can pick a date to mark, a color, and a text string.

Inputs:

daysBack = how many days back you want to examine. The default is 250 days which is 1 year of historical data. 250 trading days is equivalent to 1 year of data.

markerMonth = The month of the date you want to mark. The months are numbered 1-12 for January through December. The default is 1.

markerDay = The day of the date you want to mark. The days are numbered 1-31. The default is 1.

markerYear = The year of the date you want to mark. The default is 2013.

printColor = The display color that you want to use for the marker. The default is cyan.

marketText = The text you want to use for the marker. The default is "X".

Important Notes:

- The Date Tag ShowMe only works for Daily data so the Interval must be set for Daily.
- If you input a date for which there is no trading data a "?" will be placed above the trading date that immediately precedes the input date.

Uses:

- Can be used mark a significant date. For example, a past split date, an earnings report date, a FOMC meeting, etc.
