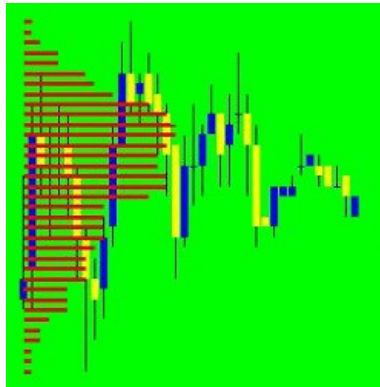


Market Profile Combination Pack



New In Version 7 & 8

- Updates to MP.ALFA, MP.RTH.ALFA and MP.ARB.ALFA:
 - Ability to draw profiles for Week, Month, and Year “sessions” (MP.ALFA)
 - Ability to calculate and color the value area and POC TPO on a tick-by-tick basis
 - Ability to display a session open caret
 - When Keep_History = False, retains the four most recent sessions; previously it was two (MP.ALFA, MP.RTH.ALFA)
 - Many more color choices
- Updates to MP.RTH, MP.ETH, MP.WEEKLY, MP.MONTHLY, MP.ARBITRARY
 - Ability to color the TPO to show the value area and POC
- Updates to the Initial Balance indicator
 - Ability to draw a vertical line to represent the Initial Balance range
 - Ability to share the IB High and IB Low with other indicators or strategies using the TradeStation Global Dictionary. This option results in output that is similar to several stand-alone Market Profile packages. Combination Pack Overview

The combination package includes nine market profile indicators PLUS Initial Balance indicators as follows:

- H.MP.RTH, H.MP.RTH.ALFA and H.MP.ALFA for regular trading hours
- H.MP.ETH and H.MP.ALFA for extended trading hours or 24 hour session
- H.MP.ARBITRARY and H.MP.ARB.ALFA for arbitrary trading time-frames
- H.MP.WEEKLY and H.MP.ALFA for weekly trading time-frames
- H.MP.MONTHLY and H.MP.ALFA for monthly trading time-frames
- H.MP.PlotR to display the market profile variables in charts of different time-frames or in a RadarScreen
- h.InitialBalance and H.IB.PlotR for initial balance during regular trading hours

This set of market profile indicators provides the trader with a toolkit for the analysis of futures, equities, and forex market profile.
